

### **INTRODUCTION**

By 2030, 1 in 5 individuals in the US will be over 65 and over increasing the demand for more aging in place programing. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) defines aging in place as "The ability to live in one's own home and community safely, independently, and comfortably, regardless of age, income, or ability level."

- Future programming should consider limitations such at time and financial resources to inform realistic implementation of sustainable programing.

### IMPLICATIONS FOR OT

This capstone is an example of how OTs can develop and improve programs for older adults to safely age in place. OTs can assist with aging in place interventions to expand upon the intersection between safety and functionality within the home environment. Similar programming can help address the growing needs of the older adult population.
